Support Level

Central and South Series: awarded 1st-5th place.

For the individual overall season awards, U12/U10 series races will be scored by age class using current "Old World Cup Points". A racer may win a series award in only one geographic area (North/Central/South). The results from the championships shall be scored separately. All results from the scheduled series races (regardless of discipline) are used to calculate the series awards. A tie is broken by a racer's best GS "Old World Cup" score(s), moving to Slalom until the tie is broken. If conditions force the cancellation of a series race, the FV/S ACC U12/U10 subcommittee determines and publicizes any necessary changes in scoring.
