- ENTRY:** \$35 per race. Online event registration for all athletes, coaches, and officials please visit adminsquiracing.com. All participants must hold a current Alpine Competitor membership with US Ski and Snowboard. All membership must be current no less than 24 hrs prior to registration. No on-site registration. No refunds or additions will be issued after the close of first TCM.
- ENTRY DEADLINE:** Registration for all entries closes Wednesday January 17, 2024, 11:59 PM. A late fee of \$40 will apply after Sunday January 14, 2024. No late entries accepted. Coaches and officials are required to register by January 14, 2024, at adminsquiracing.com
- LIFT TICKETS:** Athlete lift tickets: Child (6-12), are \$39. Discounted Parent tickets for athletes on the start list are \$94. Tickets may be purchased at Judah Ticket Window for one or all days of racing. Judah Ticket windows open at 7:30 AM as a special accommodation for this event.
- TEAM CAPTAINS' MEETING:** Day prior to event at 06:00 PM PST-Online Meeting Link and documentation will be sent ONLY to registered coaches and officials prior to event (ACR 604.3), following day TCM at finish area 1 hour after competition. All race communication will be posted on [Live-Timing](#) and [WhatsApp](#) (coaches only) Team Start order to be used as posted on fwskiing.org
- BIBS:** Bibs will be issued for all days of event to a Team Captain at morning of first race, [Judah Plaza](#) 07:30 AM PST. Teams will be charged \$50 for any unreturned bibs.
