No refunds or additions will be issued after the close of first TCM.
ENTRY DEADLINE:	Registration for all entries closes Wednesday January 17, 2024, 11:59 PM. A late fee of \$40 will apply after Sunday January 14, 2024. No late entries accepted. Coaches and officials are required to register by January 14, 2024, at <u>adminskiracing.com</u>
LIFT TICKETS:	Athlete lift tickets: Child (6-12), are \$39. Discounted Parent tickets for athletes on the start list are \$94. Tickets may be purchased at Judah Ticket Window for one or all days of racing. Judah Ticket windows open at 7:30 AM as a special accommodation for this event.
