- Check-In:** Each team will handle their own check-in at designated locations in the Sun Room beginning at 7:30 each day.
- Race Location:** Bear Boogie run located off the Polar chairlift and Featherduster run located off the Koala chairlift
- Race Schedule:** Course inspection 8:30-9:30 am. Start time 10:00 am

- Course Inspection:** **Course Inspection will be done by Teams. Inspection times will be available at Team Captains meeting.**
- Team Areas:** Areas will be designated for each team above the start. Only athletes and coaches will be permitted in these areas.
- Team Captains Meeting:** 6:00 pm Thursday Jan 8, 2026. Meeting at the Bear Valley Lodge (265 Bear Valley Rd, Bear Valley) in the Conference Room located in the hallway behind the Cathedral Lounge.
- USSS License:** **Each racer must be a current US Ski & Snowboard/Far West member.**
- Liability Release:** All racers must sign a LIABILITY RELEASE in order to compete. Liability releases must be completed during registration.

*Helmets are required for all competitors.*

- Spectators:** Spectators up the hill must be on skis / snowboard. Please no hiking up the course.
